Since I cannot now receive you Sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I know You have already come. I embrace You and unite myself entirely to You; never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.*

### \*\*\*Plenary Indulgence for Devine Mercy Sunday\*\*\*

I. The usual conditions for every plenary indulgence:

- Sacramental confession (according to previously issued norms, within about 20 days before or after).
- Eucharistic communion (according to previously issued norms, preferably on the day, or the days before or after).
- Prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff.

II. The specific conditions for this Indulgence

On Devine Mercy Sunday

- In any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honour of Devine Mercy.
- Or, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!)
