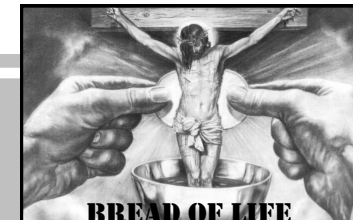

PASTOR'S NOTE: Nourished by the true Bread from Heaven...

Jesus is a much sought-after person, by virtue of his performing the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves. Even though some people might have seen the parallels between this feeding of the loaves and the feeding of Manna in the desert.
