Guideline for "fasting":

- Persons 14 or older are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent & Good Friday. Persons 18 or older, and under 59, are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- Fasting allows for 1 full meatless meal & 2 smaller meatless meals, which together should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted.
- Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
