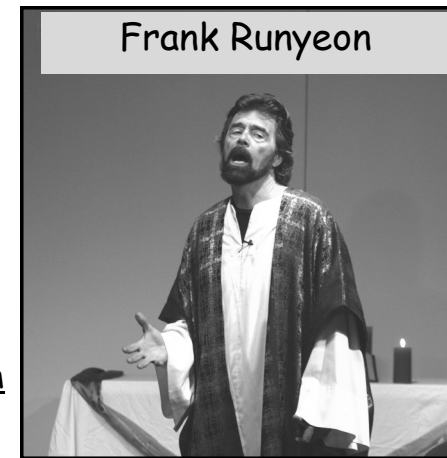
Commemorative Plates for Sale: If anyone is interested in purchasing a "Commemorative Plate", please come by the office. The cost of each plate is \$20.

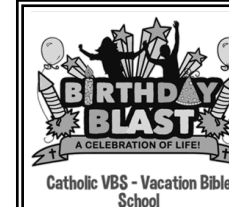
