The woman turned to her husband and asked, "What did he say?"

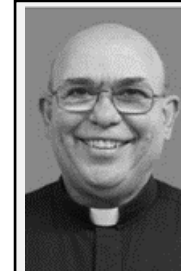
The old man yells, "He said he thinks he knows you!"

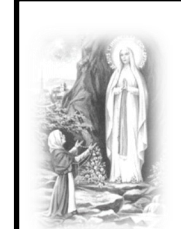
