Masses Resumed May 09 and 10

We have received Government, CDC, and Diocesan guidelines to comply with in resuming masses. These guidelines are for ensuring your safety and ours. Seating is limited to **25%** capacity. Seating will be conducted from front to back, which means you may not be able to sit where you usually do. We ask that you please comply with the ushers at all masses. The 11:00 AM and daily masses will continue to live stream on Face Book, for those not yet ready to attend. The dispensation to attend mass is extended through June. The **Chapel and cry room** will not be available. Sanitation will be done before and after each mass. The church will be locked on Fridays for cleaning and sanitation. Collection baskets will be placed at the entrance, no children's collection.

Those **65 and older** with underlying health issues are strongly encouraged to avoid attending mass. Parishioners are **encouraged** to wear a mask or other face covering upon entering the church.
