St. George Food Pantry: Food distribution will be held at St. George Parish on **Saturday, November 17th, from 8:00 -9:00 am.**

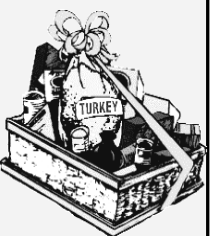
Volunteers are needed to help with the Food Pantry.
