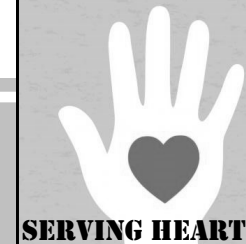

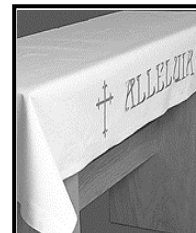
PASTOR'S NOTE: Living a life rooted in love and service...
